2014 ZINFANDEL



APPELLATION: Paso Robles, CA

WINEMAKING: Zinfandel and Syrah for this wine was yielded from our Estate Vineyard in the El Pomar District of Paso Robles. Additionally, Petite Sirah from Chalk Knoll Vineyards in San Ardo, Monterey County rounds out the blend. The wine was aged for 22 months in oak barrels. 10% new American oak and 10% new Hungarian oak.

TASTING NOTES: Dark in color with an intense nose this Zinfandel is equal parts brooding and approachable. At its core this wine explodes with ripe blackberry and juicy raspberry. Rich on the palate with white pepper spice and dark fruits yet elegant with refined tannins this wine carries to a lingering finish highlighted by the sweet vanilla character of fine oak.
