WINEMAKING: About 95% of the fruit was yielded from our Sextant Estate Vineyard in Templeton. The wine was aged 16 months in oak, 15% of which was new Hungarian and American oak.

COOPERAGE: 10% new French oak & 7% Hungarian oak aged for 23 months.
