2015 ZINFANDEL



APPELLATION: Paso Robles, CA

WINEMAKING: This hand picked fruit was sourced from our Estate Vineyard in the El Pomar sub AVA of Paso Robles. California's native grape, Zinfandel, is the centerpiece of this blend, rounded out with Syrah and Petite Sirah. Barrel aged in a mix of French and American oak for 2 years, this vibrant Zinfandel is great for any occasion.

TASTING NOTES: Dark in color with an intense nose this Zinfandel is equal parts brooding and approachable. At its core this wine explodes with ripe blackberry and juicy raspberry. Rich on the palate with white pepper spice and dark fruits yet elegant with refined tannins this wine carries to a lingering finish highlighted by the sweet vanilla character of fine oak.

COOPERAGE: 85% Zinfandel, 10% Syrah, 5% Petite Sirah
