**APPELLATION:** Paso Robles, CA

**WINEMAKING:** Hand picked fruit from the Sextant Estate Vineyard in the El Pomar district of Paso Robles. The wine was aged 18 months in oak, 15% of which was new Hungarian, French and American oak.

**TASTING NOTES:** Medium ruby in color. Dusty sweet Marachino cherries, blackberry, kirsch, with a hint of vanilla and toasty oak on the nose. Medium to full bodied, lush tannins, bright black cherry, blackberry, medium to long finish with kirsch, blackberry, and sweet vanilla.

**COOPERAGE:** 55% Syrah, 36% Grenache, 8% Petite Sirah
