**APPELLATION:** Paso Robles, CA

**WINEMAKING:** Sourced from the best sub-appellations in Paso Robles, this wine is aged for 8 months in 20% French Oak.

**TASTING NOTES** A lively core of vibrant acidity and supple tannins frame undulating contours of plums, figs, raspberries, and cherries. Hints of smoky pepper, dark chocolate, and dusty sage appear on the appealing finish that lingers with freshness and persistence. Our Paso Robles appellation continues to produce expressive and balanced Cabernet Sauvignon fruit with signature quality and finesse.
